



How businesses are getting ready for **MTD**

Making Tax Digital (MTD) for VAT reporting starts from April 2019 and introduces significant new rules impacting how the majority of organisations will submit their returns.

MTD for VAT focuses on three key requirements:

- **Digital record keeping** – storing all transactions in electronic form
- **Digital links** – have a digital link between final numbers and source data
- **Digital submissions** – all submissions must be made using appropriate software via HMRC's new gateway

I already file quarterly, does this apply to me?

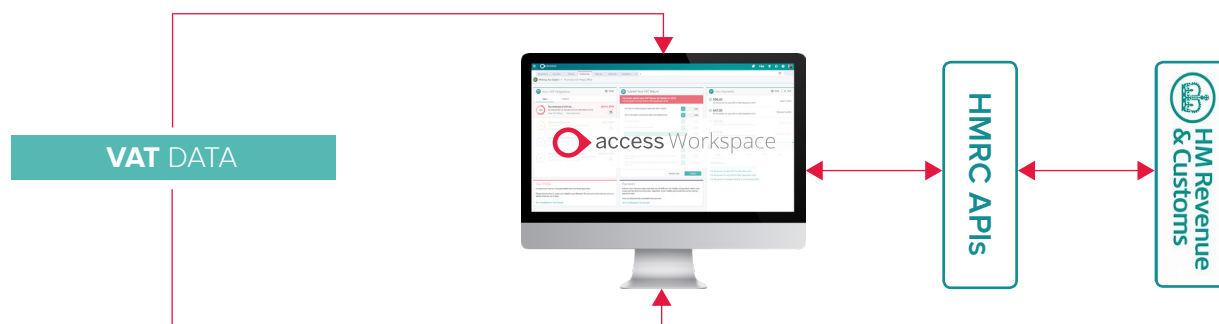
Yes, it does. From April 2019 MTD will be mandatory for all businesses above the VAT-threshold. This means you will be required to keep digital records as well as file your VAT digitally to HMRC every three months through compliant accounting software.

Access's Application is HMRC approved and works with both Access and Non-Access Accounting Software. You will just need to check that the information that HMRC holds on your business is accurate prior to taking steps to ensuring you are filing digitally.
