With over 700 employees, Minerva Learning Trust, comprising of four schools formed a multi academy trust to provide the best educational experience to all the pupils, allowing them the opportunity to develop and achieve their potential.

Minerva Learning Trust is an ambitious Multi-Academy Trust (MAT) serving four schools across Sheffield. It was established as a Single Academy Trust in 2014 and rapidly expanded in the period December 2017 to March 2018 taking on three additional secondary schools. It was recognised that key operating functions such as Finance, Budgets and Curriculum were being handled separately across the schools and was neither practical nor efficient and definitely not future proof which is crucial in an ever expanding Trust.

Manual processes to maintain the various systems by the different teams wasn't conducive to the way that the Trust should be operating, meaning that key stakeholders were hindered, delayed and unable to make strategic decisions as they didn't have access to the necessary information when needed.
