Tim Marsh is the Business Director at Every Child Matters Academy Trust, a Yorkshire MAT made up of eight primary schools.

How has Access Education's software benefitted your trust?

As we've grown the software has easily helped us to review, monitor and report all elements of trust budgeting.

We academised as three schools, before becoming five and then eight in July 2020. This means 'number crunching' has to be accurate and timely – our staff appreciate a quick turnaround on any budget or costing enquiries. We were previously using Excel sheets so it has saved us a lot of time as it's easy to bring other schools onboard and provide a single, consolidated and professional-looking report.

This ability to forward plan is incredibly helpful.

This also applies to calculating additional salaries as we already know what is feasible for both full-time and potential support staff.

Are there any particular features you find most useful?

As I've mentioned the salary calculator is hugely useful in helping us make decisions around both teaching and support staff. We can simulate different scenarios and the potential impact of these – from the cost to recruit teams on different grades, versus the savings we make if we have to lose staff.

It's a massive help when the individual school business managers have questions or want to work with their respective headteacher on future planning.

We're also benefitting from being able to change between establishments within one login – it's a huge timesaver.

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It's exceptionally easy to produce management accounts and it is easy to follow with a clear 'narrative'. I have received a lot of positive feedback from governors and trustees!

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The ability to duplicate orders and invoices, as well as the functionality to search by name, information or number, really helps the team to efficiently complete tasks.

What other benefits have you seen thanks to the software?

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As a result of the Covid-19 lockdown and the move to remote working, we quickly realised we could still efficiently use the (Access Education) software during Zoom calls.
