Since becoming Director of finance and operations at the rapidly expanding St Bartholomew's CE Multi-Academy Trust, Christopher Dryer has been focused on the aim of implementing a fully centralised finance strategy.

Here, Christopher explains some of the main benefits of the **Access Finance and Budgeting** software and how it's helping achieve these aims.

Having transitioned from a maintained school to a multi-academy trust back in 2016, we knew we needed a system that was intuitive and simple to use to help our team get to grips with new processes and ways of working.
