We're excited to announce the **early release** of an additional industry skill for Access Evo Copilot. The AASB skill is now available within Access Evo. This new AI-powered skill provides accountants with instant, accurate guidance on Australian Accounting Standards, sustainability reporting frameworks, and financial compliance requirements — all from within Access Evo.

Copilot draws on authoritative AASB source material and cites specific standards in its responses, enabling practitioners to deliver well-referenced, defensible advice to clients with confidence.

What's Included

AASB Standards Guidance — Explain specific standards and their application in financial reporting. Covers compliance requirements, recent updates, and worked examples.

Sustainability Standards — Guidance on ESG and sustainability disclosure requirements in Australia, including ISSB-aligned standards (AASB S1 and S2) and mandatory reporting timelines.

Standards Research — Find the relevant accounting or sustainability standard for a specific scenario, with references to official AASB documentation.

4. Review the response and follow up with additional questions as needed.
